# DRINKING WATER PRODUCTION COURSE

Competent personnel at waterworks is necessary for safe drinking water production. The plant utilised during the course can be used to prepare potable water and to examine the unit processes of water treatment and the various problems that may occur during water production.

The course provides a practical outlook and knowledge concerning

- Water treatment processes
- Continuous measurements and adjustments as part of process management
- Precipitation processes
- Disinfection methods
- Residual treatment.

The course contents can be tailored to meet the client's needs. The course is also suitable for those operating groundwater treatment plants.
