

COURSE IN WOUND MANAGEMENT

Cost efficiency and the prevention of infections play a key role when choosing treatment methods and products for wounds with different etiologies. The comprehensive, high-quality care of a wound patient involves identifying the causes of wounds, managing the healing processes and being able to choose the most appropriate treatment. The four-day course organised by Savonia University of Applied Sciences helps participants to develop their knowledge and skills in modern wound care. The course will consist of skills workshops and lectures – a perfect blend to reach permanent learning results.

The professional competence of nursing staff is challenged by the diverse range of wounds, their numerous treatment methods and different operating environments. In order to manage healing process and avert complications skills and knowledge must be constantly updated to stay ahead in the race of product development in the field. The prevention and early recognition of wound infections facilitate humane, high-quality and cost-efficient care.

The course motivates participants to bring their skills and knowledge concerning new wound management methods up-to-date through the following themes:

1. Causes and healing of wounds and the prevention of infections
2. Wound care with different etiologies
3. Products and equipment used in wound care
4. Development of wound management in patient care.

Wound management

The four-day course for health care professionals organised by Savonia University of Applied Sciences helps participants to develop their knowledge and skills in modern wound care.

■ The course will take place either in Finland or in a native country location. It will be organized with the diverse network of health care and wound care product manufacturer organizations from both the public and private sectors.

■ The course consists of diverse learning methods; workshops, activating lectures and discussions besides skill stations and simulations.
